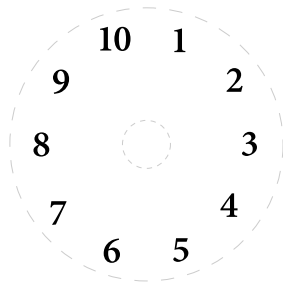
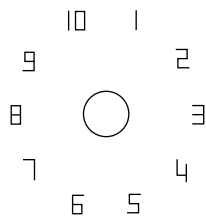


This template can be used for placement of your own numbers. Cut out and center over the switch's shaft. With a pin, lightly poke a hole through the paper at the intersection of each ray and the circle the distance you want from the center.



This template can be printed and cut to use as-is. Punch a hole in the middle for the switch shaft, then attach to your counting box.



This is the layout I used for my laser-cut counting box. The numbers are all made from straight lines for ease of engraving.
